

Canadian Association of Elizabeth Fry Societies' Memorial Bursary - 2022 Application Guidelines

Who and what is eligible for this bursary?

This bursary supports incarcerated or formerly women and gender-diverse people in achieving their education or employment goals. You must be living in Canada to be eligible.

How much do successful bursary applicants receive?

Bursaries are for \$750 each.

What is the deadline to apply?

Applications should be received by CAEFS no later than June 29th, 2022.

How do I submit my application?

How will my application be evaluated?

Your application will be evaluated based on if you have a clearly stated goal and a plan to achieve that goal. It will also take into consideration if you have faced or are facing barriers in achieving your goal that this bursary might help you to overcome. We encourage you to list other ways that CAEFS or a local Elizabeth Fry Society might help you in achieving your goal, but those questions will not be used to evaluate your application.

How many bursaries are available?

We will be distributing up to 3 bursaries per region, depending on the availability of funds.

When will I know if my bursary application was successful?

All applicants will be notified if their bursary was successful or not in August by email or mail, depending on how the application was received.

If my application is successful, when and how will I receive my bursary?

Successful applications will receive their bursary by mail by cheque in August 2022.
