



Memorial Bursary Application ATLANTIC REGION

CAEFS Memorial bursary supports incarcerated or formerly women and gender-diverse people in achieving their education or employment goals.

Who can apply?

Your application will be considered if you meet all of the following criteria:

- You live in Canada
- You are a woman or gender-diverse person
- You have been, or are currently, incarcerated

How much is the bursary for ?

Bursaries are \$750 each.

When is the deadline to apply?

Applications must be received no later than June 30th, 2023.

How do I submit my application?

The application process described below is for applicants in the Atlantic Region (Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, and Prince Edward Island) only. If you are based in another region please review the application guidelines for your specific region, available at caefs.ca or by contacting your regional advocacy team

How will my application be evaluated?

Your application will be evaluated based on if you have a clearly stated goal and a plan to achieve that goal. It will also take into consideration if you have faced or are facing barriers in achieving your goal that this bursary might help you to overcome.

How many bursaries are available?

We will be distributing up to 3 bursaries per region, 4 in the Prairies depending on the availability of funds.

When will I know if my bursary application was successful?

All applicants will be notified if their bursary was successful or not in August by email or mail, depending on how the application was received.

If my application is successful, when and how will I receive my bursary?

Successful applications will receive their bursary by mail by cheque, by September 2023. If you are currently incarcerated and are looking or have applied for a transfer, please let us know where to contact you if you are the successful recipient(s).
